

Laundry Room Rules

The key to a well-functioning laundry room is fairness and mutual consideration.

- The laundry room and drying areas are solely for the use of the respective tenant during the days and times specified in the laundry schedule. Depending on the property, tenants may be able to reserve a time slot or have a fixed time available for washing and drying. During this time, the tenant is responsible for adhering to the laundry room rules.
- Washing and drying are permitted on working days between 7.00 am and 10.00 pm.
- After use, the rooms and appliances, especially the filters, must be thoroughly cleaned and dried. The floors should be swept and, if possible, mopped. Store your belongings such as washing powder in your designated cellar. Waste such as empty detergent containers must not be disposed of in the general waste bin in the laundry room.
- Please take care of the devices. Follow the operating instructions for the appliances. Always check for foreign objects in the laundry that could damage the machine. Bras should be washed in a separate laundry bag, and curtains should also be washed separately.
- To prevent the washing machine from foaming over, use a minimal amount of washing powder. Do not exceed the detergent manufacturer's instructions. (If possible, always wash with full loads, as this is friendlier to the environment. Do not overfill.)
- The rooms should be well ventilated during and especially after washing. For proper ventilation, open the windows, but never the doors to interior rooms, to prevent vapour from entering the stairwell and cellar rooms. In winter, windows must be kept closed overnight.
- The tenant is responsible for any damage caused during the period of use. Report any defects found in the laundry room upon arrival to the caretaker or the administration; otherwise, the next user may be held responsible.
- Tenants are not allowed to wash laundry in the laundry room for individuals living away from home or for those not part of the family.
